



PRIVACY POLICY

1. This privacy policy (hereinafter the "Privacy Policy") sets out and outlines the basis on which any personal data collected by INTERNATIONAL EVENTS SERVICES, S.L.U. (*hereinafter, "IES"*), or that you may provide, will be processed by IES. For the purpose of current Regulations, IES is considered the data controller.
2. This Privacy Policy shall apply to IES' processing of your personal data when you enter and use the website www.vipvillage.motogp.com.
3. According with the provisions of current Regulation, the User is informed that the access to the Website www.vipvillage.motogp.com does not imply that the User is obliged to provide any personal information.
4. However, the use of certain of the services available on the Web depends on the User's registration, and the completion by the User of personal information forms.
5. Additionally, we inform you that certain functionalities of the Website depend on the use of cookies. Certain information related to the use of Website by the Users may be processed, unless the User have denied the possibility of using such cookies. Users can request more information by reading the "Cookies Policy".
6. If you decide to validate your account using any external platform (such as Facebook, Google, LinkedIn or others), IES will be informed of the corresponding identification and other data (including your email when consent will be given). We also inform you that there is no link between IES and these external platforms, so you need to accept their corresponding privacy policy and terms of use once you access them and/or validate their terms and conditions in the procedure of registration. IES shall not be responsible for the use or processing of your data that is made outside the strict relationship and provision of services indicated in these policies. The necessary personal data for providing the different services available on the Website will be the indicated in the corresponding form enabled in respect to that effect. The refusal to provide the personal data necessary for providing such services implies the impossibility of providing the particular service requested.
7. IES collects data for the purposes of operating the Web, providing different services available on the Web and to provide you with the best possible experiences when using our products or services. Some of this data is directly provided by you, such as when you create an account and register to the Web, acquires certain products and/or services from the Web or contacts IES for support. Other data is obtained by IES from your activity, use and interactions in the Web by way of, but not limited to, cookies or other technologies, or received from third parties. Specifically, IES collects and processes:
 - a) Information provided by you. Data given by you (i) by filling in different forms contained in the Web, (ii) when contacting and/or interacting with IES by e-mail, phone, social media profiles, chats or other means -i.e. contacting with customer service, contacting technical support, requesting information, etc. (iii) when connecting to the Web using external platforms or (iv) when answering certain information specifically requested by IES -i.e. surveys, customer satisfaction templates, know your customer forms etc.
 - b) Information automatically collected by IES. IES may automatically collect (i) technical information from you, such as but not limited your internet protocol (IP) address, login details and related information, geographic location of each connection to the services, type of device used to connect to the Web, network, time zone settings, operating system, browser information and plug-in types and/or other technical information, as well as (ii) information related to your use of the web, platform or services, such as but not limited to, your journey on the relevant web, URL clickstream to pages or content visited and/or searched or clicks, scrolling and other interaction information that may be available.
 - c) Information received from third parties. IES may collect and process personal data received from third parties, such as but not limited to partners, sponsors or licensees, when such third parties have a contract or agreement in place with the relevant individual(s), either if such individuals are or become registered users to the Web or not, which allows the transfer of your personal data to third parties or when an individual may register on third parties services to receive communications from other third parties. IES will duly inform such individuals that is has collected and is processing its personal data according and subject to this Privacy Policy. IES may combine the information it receives from these third parties with the information IES directly collects, in which case we will use and treat it in accordance with this Privacy Policy.
8. IES may use your personal data for different purposes relying on a lawful basis as required by the current Regulations. As further explained below, the lawful basis we rely on are (a) to fulfil contracts, (b) where we have a legitimate interest, (c) where we obtain your consent and (d) where we have a legal obligation.
 - a) In order to be able to fulfil a contract with you, such as but not limited to when you register as a user, subscribe to a service, purchase a product or participate in a promotion, IES needs and is entitled to process your personal data to effectively provide the services (thus fulfil the contract) and, when applicable, billing/charging for those services or products. Should you choose not to provide the relevant personal data needed, IES may not be able to provide the relevant services or products.

We understand our legitimate interests as the interest in and right to improve or enhance our products and services, to create new products and services, to provide our services in the most efficiently way possible, to promote and develop our business, to operate and administer our business, both internally and externally, or to exercise our rights, among others. Based on IES's legitimate interest, we may use the information (either provided by you, recorded by IES or provided by a third party) for different purposes such as (but not limited to) providing you services/products, to manage your account, to analyze of the Web and your use of the Web, to keep records of the acquisition of products and services, to

conduct verifications and fraud detection checks, to communicate with you, to conduct market search, to participate in surveys, to create an individual profile for your (or groups) to better understand our customers, to improve and/or personalizing the Web (including advertising), to improve your user experience and/or quality and security of our services, to participate in contests, quizzes or prize draws, to send you regular information (by any means or media) related to conditions and benefits for registered users, as well as sending information of our events, products and/or services, offers and promotions (such as upcoming events, offers, MotoGP VIP Village information and promotions, etc.) related to motorsports competitions. These personal data could be processed by automated means. You may oppose to the personal data processing for certain purposes by communicating to IES (You will have a simple process to unsubscribe in each of the received communications).

- b) Where we obtain your consent, IES may use your profile and contact data to send, even after the contractual relationship has ended, marketing communications in relation to products and services offered by IES and its sponsors, partners, service providers or third parties related to IES or motorcycling. You can revoke or cancel the consent at any moment by communicating to IES.
 - d) Where we have a legal obligation imposed by mandatory applicable laws or regulations IES shall process your personal data according and subject to the provisions of such laws or regulations, which may include provision of your personal data to law enforcement authorities.
9. The protection of children's privacy is of the utmost importance for IES. The Web is not directed to and the content is not intended for children under sixteen (16) years of ages. IES recommends that parents and/or guardians of children supervise their children's activities online and adopt parental control tools on their browsers. IES will not knowingly collect and/or process personal data from children.

Parents or guardians of children under sixteen (16) who believe that its children have created an account without its permission and that, accordingly, IES might have personal data from their children, can contact IES at motogpvipvillage@dorna.com.

10. For the purpose of keeping your personal data updated, User shall inform IES of any change that may occur with respect to the User's personal data. IES reserves the right to carry out the corresponding controls to verify the authenticity of the personal data provided, as a means of avoiding fraudulent use of the services offered on the Website.
11. As long as the User shall not expressly cancel their personal data, it will remain as valid personal data, until such personal data is canceled according to the internal procedures of IES, considering that the personal data is no longer appropriate for the stated purpose.
12. In any case, IES reserves the right to keep your data (but duly blocked) in case that it is necessary to comply with the obligations and responsibilities imposed by mandatory applicable laws or regulations, or upon request of the corresponding competent authority according to law.
13. IES has adopted technical and organizational measures to guarantee the confidentiality, integrity, availability and permanent resilience of every systems and processing services, as well as avoiding alteration, loss, treatment or unauthorized access to such personal data.
14. Your personal data may be communicated to or shared with:
 - a) IES's necessary service and/or analytics providers (data processors), even when such communication could be the object of an international data transfer to countries located outside the European Economic Area, including countries that do not provide an adequate data protection level, equivalent to European Regulation. In such cases, any legal steps shall be taken in order to guarantee an adequate data protection level.
 - b) Any third party that may acquire IES's business assets in the process of a merger, acquisition, or assignment, based on IES's legitimate interest.
 - c) Any law enforcement authorities when IES has a legal obligation to communicate or share your personal data.
15. You are hereby informed that you may exercise your rights, free of charge and when deemed appropriate, as established in the current regulations, in relation to:
 - **Opposition to data processing made in virtue of the legitimate interest of IES, including the right to object to decisions based solely on automated data processing.**
 - **Revocation or cancellation to the consent granted.**
 - **Access to own personal data.**
 - **Rectification of inaccurate or incomplete data.**
 - **Request of personal data deletion.**
 - **Obtain the limitation of the processing of its data when any of the conditions provided in the data protection regulations is met.**
 - **Request the portability of its personal data.**

16. To exercise any of such rights mentioned in section above, you address to IES's domicile, at Calle Príncipe de Vergara 183, 28002, Madrid (Spain) and/or may send e-mail to motogpvipvillage@dorna.com IES may require that you send a photocopy of a document proving your identity.

17. If you consider that any of your rights may have been violated, you shall file a complaint with the "National Control Authority" regarding the protection of personal data.

18. This Privacy Policy is under continual review and updated to reflect applicable privacy regulations. IES may update this Privacy Policy from time to time, it being agreed that any change or update will be posted and available in this section. IES reserves the right to amend or change this Privacy Policy at any time. IES encourages you to frequently access this section in order to be informed and aware of any changes to the Privacy Policy.
